

Final Adjustment for Leather Top PaleoShoes:

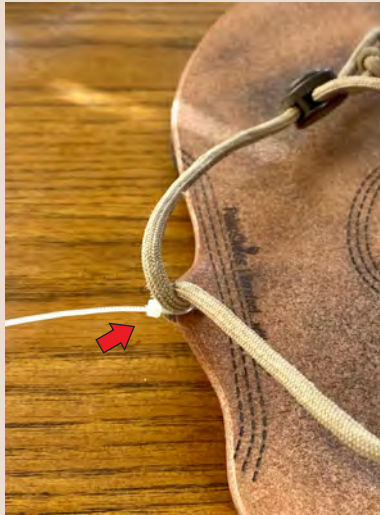


After about a 40 mile break-in period the leather topped sandals are ready to have the final adjustment locked into place. Check that you have a good fit with the feet comfortably positioned near the front of the sandals then follow these procedures to lock in a comfortable fit.

Step 1) Center the foot on the sole pad by pulling on the **Inside Lace A**. Up moves the foot forward, down moves the foot back.



Step 2) Wrap a cord tie around the lace where it crosses itself as close to the eyelet as possible, then pull the cord tie tight.



Step 3) Use scissors to nip the excess cord tie. Then position the cut ends away from the foot.



Step 4) Attach small pieces of tape on the foot to protect the skin until it adapts to the cord ties.



Step 5) For races and for a tighter fit move the keeper knot down against the cordlock.



Step 6) If desired tie a second lace knot to take up any excess slack.



Note: Water Moccasins don't need cord ties to keep the fit secure and comfortable.

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
